In other Borough matters:

A member of the audience voiced their concern over a blighted property at 204 Grove Street. It was stated that the owner passed away and it is now in the daughter's hands. Officer Alaimo will follow up and try to make contact with the daughter/current owner.

Marcy Earls, Astound Broadband, addressed Council about a potential franchise agreement between Astound and the Borough to offer cable tv to Avoca resident.

Stan Spagnuolo gave Council several updates from the street department regarding road patching, projects and ordinance compliance properties.

Resident Mike Haddock prepared and gave a letter to all Council members regarding his concerns over the new UCC Inspector, BHW Construction Consultation Services. After a bit of discussion, Atty. Boyd advised all inspectors are licensed and certified to perform their jobs through the State.

Mike Fuller followed up with Council regarding a meeting the fire committee had with members of the fire department.
